Mashpee Senior Center, 26 Frank E Hicks Drive, Mashpee

This free event is co-sponsored by the Mashpee Environmental Coalition and Mashpee Department of Public Works. As it is now illegal to discard any/all items made of textiles in the trash, residents can drop off bags of clean and dry **bedding**, **clothes**, **shoes**, **towels**, **curtains**, **accessories**, **and even stuffed animals** – including those that are ripped, frayed, and stained. At the same time, aSecure Shredding Company will be onsite to safely dispose of documents containing personal and confidential information. And, for those interested in composting, information plus a **free kitchen food scrap bucket** will be distributed by Mashpee DPW, with home compost bins also available for purchase. 
